

# HELP NOTE

## Inspector Requirements



- ✓ Inspector needs to be wearing a Hi-Visibility (Hi-Vis) garment. The TTMC-W on the tag shows compliance of the garment.
- ✓ The Hi-Vis must be worn done up and be in an acceptable condition.



- ✓ Beacons should comply with ECE Regulation 65



- ✓ Mount beacons where they can be seen 360 degrees around the vehicle.
- ✓ Beacons must not be obstructed by roof racks, ladders etc.

- ✓ The inspector will need to comply with their company's requirements for PPE. i.e. safety footwear, long sleeve shirt, long trousers etc.



Vehicle will need to have a "Road Inspection" sign visible from the rear.

The sign must not cover tail lights or registration



The registration plate must be visible. Use a supplementary plate if required.
