

HELP NOTE

Inspector Requirements



- Inspector needs to be wearing a Hi-Visibility (Hi-Vis) garment. The TTMC-W on the tag shows compliance of the garment.
- The Hi-Vis must be worn done up and be in an acceptable condition.



Beacons should comply with ECE Regulation 65



- Mount beacons where they can be seen 360 degrees around the vehicle.
- Beacons must not be obstructed by roof racks, ladders etc.

The inspector will need to comply with their company's requirements for PPE. i.e. safety footwear, long sleeve shirt, long trousers etc.





Vehicle will need to have a "Road Inspection" sign visible from the rear.

The sign must not cover tail lights or registration



The registration plate must be visible. Use a supplementary plate if required.
